The Interactive Brokers Trader Workstation (TWS) has properties that must be set in order for Ensign to receive data. In the TWS platform select File | Global Configuration.



The 'API - Settings' window will open as shown below.

- 1. Expand the 'API' menu.
- 2. Select the 'Settings' sub-menu.
- 3. Check the box for 'Enable ActiveX and Socket Clients'.
- 4. Check the box for 'Allow connections from localhost only'.
- 5. Click the 'OK' button to close the window.



Click the 'General' menu and set the 'Memory Allocation' to 2048 as shown below.
